

HOW WE KEEP OUR COMMUNITY SAFE

FrogLegs is working hard to make sure we can provide a safe, happy and fun experience. We are following the State guidelines that have been created for In-person classes.

Procedures We Have Put Into Place Include:

- We require everyone to wear masks and face coverings.
 - Exceptions will be made during lunch time in our morning Summer Camps.
- Classes will be limited to 50% capacity.
- All staff, families, children and their household members must conduct a health check and their temperature will be taken upon arrival.
 - Should anyone have a low-grade fever (temperature over 99.5 F) we kindly ask you to stay home and will transfer you to a future class of your choice.
- We require everyone to wash their hands with soap and warm water as soon as they enter our facility.
- Frequent handwashing will be in place as always.
- Seats will be set apart as far as possible to allow for social distancing.
- A Sanitation Lead will be wiping down high use areas around our retail, kitchens and bathrooms.
- At the end of each class, our kitchens will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized.
- Common area toys will be sanitized daily.

We are looking forward creating a great environment to keep the children engaged and allow for a safe and delicious experience. We understand that many of the aspects of our camp will need to be adjusted and we have accounted for those. We will continue to update our procedures as we see is necessary and best for the kids and the families.
